Document subtitle

• authors: ['Author Name 1', 'Author Name 2']

This is written on the front page. May be omitted.

main\_author: 'Author Name 1'

This is the contact person on the front page and used in footer.

• email: 'test@example.com'

This is the email adress of the contact person on the front page and used in footer.

• date: 2021-07-01

The date of the document. Use \today to use current date.

• institution: Lillebaelt Academy (default: "UCL university college")

For the front page. Don't change this, since it matches the logo.

• left-header: 2021-07-01

Header text to the left.

right-header: Template test

Header text to the right. Use document title if in doubt.

• skip-toc: false (Default: false)

Skip table of content. Usable for short documents.

skip-lof: false (Default: false)

Skip list of figures. Usable for documents with few figures.

status: draft (Default: empty)

Show a watermark across all pages with the word written as status. Default is no

watermark.
